The excellent news is they can be swapped out without changing the entire fireplace. Test-fire the indoor gas ignition under the logs and also make certain it lights appropriately.

Odor is a noticeable giveaway, however to make sure, clean some water mixed with meal soap over the lines, valves and also ports and also look for bubbles the indicator of a leakage. Dust bunnies, dead pests, pet dog hair all can build up in your gas fireplace, so this is the time to vacuum them out.

If you do not have a carbon monoxide monitor mounted near your fire place, include one. You don't require a Mary Poppins-style chimney sweeper for a gas fire place, but you do need to check the exterior smokeshaft framework and the interior walls in front of and also around the chimney. With gas fire places, the largest danger to the smokeshaft is condensation.

If you have not called the pros yet, it's time to make the telephone call. Just how typically you obtain a gas fire place service check depends upon exactly how frequently you utilize the fireplace. If you like a roaring fire from autumn all the means through spring, you must conduct or schedule solution once a year, preferably early in the summertime.

Replace your carbon monoxide gas detectors every five years or two. This method if your gas fireplace is not airing vent properly, you'll be alerted. The price for gas fireplace maintenance will depend on where you live, the size as well as condition of your fireplace as well as whether the service phone call is immediate. Expect to invest between \$100 and \$200, although in some areas it might be much greater.
